****NOTES****

1. The graduation uniform will be Class A's or ASU's with beret.
2. TDY personnel must bring all TA-50 items listed on the packing list. Individuals from unique unit's without access to a CIF can sign TA-50 items out from the NCOA supply on a case by case basis. Weapons will be issued as needed to TDY personnel from the NCOA.
3. If you are prescribed medication from a medical doctor, you must bring enough to sustain yourself throughout the duration on the course. Official documentation from your PCM must reflect type, quantity, and duration of medication. All medication must be secured in wall locker.
4. There is no ATM machines located at the Academy. The Shopette will be available several days during the cycle. It is recommended that all students bring at least \$75.00. Students will be given the opportunity to purchase a commemorative T-shirt, DVD, and Photo upon completion of the course. The shopette only accepts cash. (Non Meal Card holders will be required to pay for DFAC meals)
